- hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6102 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 9 § 6102. Definitions.
- 10 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 11 provisions of this subchapter which are applicable to specific
- 12 provisions of this subchapter, the following words and phrases,
- when used in this subchapter shall have, unless the context 13
- 14 clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this
- 15 section:
- 16
- "Registry of firearm ownership." Any list, database, record 17

- 1 or registry of privately owned firearms or any list, database,
- 2 record or registry reflecting the sale, transfer or ownership of
- 3 those firearms. The term includes, but is not limited to, any
- 4 <u>list</u>, <u>database</u>, <u>record</u> or <u>registry</u> <u>reflecting</u> an <u>application</u> or
- 5 other record reflecting the sale or transfer of a firearm. For
- 6 the purposes of this definition only, the term "firearm" shall
- 7 <u>include any weapon that is designed or may readily be converted</u>
- 8 to expel any projectile by the action of an explosive or the
- 9 frame or receiver of any such weapon.

- 13 § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms.

- 15 (b) Duty of seller.--No licensed importer, licensed
- 16 manufacturer or licensed dealer shall sell or deliver any
- 17 firearm to another person, other than a licensed importer,
- 18 licensed manufacturer, licensed dealer or licensed collector,
- 19 until the conditions of subsection (a) have been satisfied and
- 20 until he has:

- 22 (1.1) On the date of publication in the Pennsylvania
- 23 Bulletin of a notice by the Pennsylvania State Police that
- the instantaneous records check has been implemented, all of
- 25 the following shall apply:

- (v) Unless it has been discovered pursuant to a
- criminal history, juvenile delinquency and mental health
- 29 records background check that the potential purchaser or
- 30 transferee is prohibited from possessing a firearm

1 pursuant to section 6105 (relating to persons not to 2 possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer 3 firearms), no information on the application/record of sale provided [pursuant to this subsection] for any 4 5 firearm, as defined in subsection (f)(1), shall be retained as precluded by section 6111.4 (relating to 6 7 registration of firearms) by the Pennsylvania State 8 Police either through retention of the application/record 9 of sale or by entering the information onto a computer, 10 and, further, an application/record of sale received by 11 the Pennsylvania State Police pursuant to this subsection 12 shall be destroyed within 72 hours of the completion of

- 29 transfer of firearms) shall be subject to a fine of not more
- 30 than \$10,000, imprisoned for not more than 15 years or both.

- 1 (c) <u>Definition.--</u>For the purposes of this section only, the
- 2 term "firearm" shall include any weapon that is designed to or
- 3 may readily be converted to expel any projectile by the action
- 4 of an explosive or the frame or receiver of any such weapon.
- 5 Section 3. Any government or law enforcement agency or any
- 6 agent thereof that currently possesses, controls, maintains or
- 7 operates a registry of firearm ownership created or compiled
- 8 using information on an application/record of sale provided
- 9 pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. § 6111 shall destroy the registry of
- 10 firearm ownership.
- 11 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
