AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for limitation on the regulation 3 of firearms and ammunition. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 6120(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 6120. Limitation on the regulation of firearms and 10 ammunition. 11 * * * 12 13 (a.2) Unlawful regulation. --14 (1) A person adversely affected by any ordinance, 15 resolution, rule or practice promulgated or enforced in violation of subsection (a) or of 53 Pa.C.S. 2962(q) 16

1	(relating to limitation on municipal powers) may file suit in
2	an appropriate court for declarative and injunctive relief
3	and for all actual and consequential damages attributable to
4	the violation.
5	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a party
6	who brings or maintains an action at law or in equity against
7	a political subdivision that has regulated the otherwise
8	lawful ownership, possession, storage, carrying, transfer or
9	transportation of firearms, ammunition or ammunition
10	components in violation of subsection (a) or of 53 Pa.C.S. §
11	2962(g) shall be entitled to all of the following:
12	(i) Reimbursement of actual damages and reasonable
13	attorney fees and costs incurred if, within 30 days of
14	commencement of the action but prior to a final
15	determination by a court in favor of either party, the
16	political subdivision rescinds or repeals the ordinance,
17	resolution, rule or practice at issue in the action.
18	(ii) Prejudgment liquidated damages if, after the
19	expiration of the 30-day period under paragraph (1) but
20	prior to a final determination by a court in favor of
21	either party, the political subdivision rescinds or
22	repeals the ordinance, resolution, rule or practice at
23	issue in the action.
24	(iii) Postjudgment liquidated damages upon a final
25	determination by a court in favor of the party who brings
26	or maintains the action.
27	(3) If a court finds that the county, municipality or
28	township violated subsection (a) or 53 Pa.C.S. § 2962(g), the
29	court may impose a civil penalty on the county, municipality
30	or township of up to \$5,000.

- 1 (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 3 subsection:
- 4 "Ammunition or ammunition components." Fixed cartridge
- 5 ammunition, shotqun shells, the individual components of fixed
- 6 cartridge ammunition and shotgun shells, projectiles for
- 7 <u>muzzleloading firearms and any propellant used in firearms or</u>
- 8 ammunition.
- 9 "Dealer." The term shall include any person engaged in the
- 10 business of selling at wholesale or retail a firearm or
- 11 ammunition.
- 12 "Firearms." This term shall have the meaning given to it in
- 13 section 5515 (relating to prohibiting of paramilitary training)
- 14 but shall not include air rifles as that term is defined in
- 15 section 6304 (relating to sale and use of air rifles).
- "Person adversely affected." Any of the following:
- 17 (1) Any person who otherwise has standing under the laws
- of this Commonwealth to bring an action under this section.
- 19 (2) Any person who meets all of the following:
- 20 <u>(i) Can legally possess a firearm under the laws of</u>
- this Commonwealth and the United States.
- 22 <u>(ii) Owns, possesses, stores, transports, carries or</u>
- transfers firearms, ammunition or ammunition components
- within a political subdivision or would do so but for the
- 25 <u>ordinance, resolution, rule or practice in a political</u>
- 26 <u>subdivision</u>.
- 27 <u>(iii) Is or, if present in a political subdivision,</u>
- would be subject to the ordinance, resolution, rule or
- 29 practice in the political subdivision, whether or not
- 30 specific enforcement action has been initiated or

- 1 <u>threatened against the person.</u>
- 2 (3) A membership organization, the members of which
- 3 include a person described under this paragraph, that is
- 4 <u>dedicated in whole or in part to protecting the legal, civil</u>
- 5 <u>or constitutional rights of its membership.</u>
- 6 "Political subdivision." The term shall include any home
- 7 rule charter municipality, county, city, borough, incorporated
- 8 town, township or school district.
- 9 "Postjudgment liquidated damages." A sum equal to three
- 10 times the actual damages, reasonable attorney fees and costs
- 11 incurred by a party who successfully brings or maintains an
- 12 action described under subsection (a.2)(2).
- 13 "Prejudgment liquidated damages." A sum equal to two times
- 14 the actual damages, reasonable attorney fees and costs incurred
- 15 by a party who brings or maintains an action described under
- 16 subsection (a.2)(2).
- 17 Section 2. The amendment or addition of 18 Pa.C.S. §
- 18 6120(a.2) and (b) shall apply to an ordinance, rule, resolution
- 19 or policy adopted by a political subdivision or to official
- 20 actions taken by an employee or agent of a political
- 21 subdivision, before, on or after the effective date of this
- 22 section.
- 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
