## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 3 articles, further providing for firearms not to be carried without a license. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Section 6106(b)(11) and (15) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 6106. Firearms not to be carried without a license. 10 \* \* \* 11 (b) Exceptions. -- The provisions of subsection (a) shall not 12 apply to: \* \* \* 13 14 Any person while carrying a firearm in any vehicle, 15 which person possesses a valid and lawfully issued license [for that] to carry a firearm which has been issued under the 16

1 laws of the United States or any other state.

3 (15) Any person who possesses a valid and lawfully
4 issued license or permit to carry a firearm which has been
5 issued under the laws of another state, regardless of whether
6 a reciprocity agreement exists between the Commonwealth and
7 the other state under section 6109(k), provided[:

- (i) The] <u>the other</u> state provides a reciprocal privilege for individuals licensed to carry firearms under section 6109.
- [(ii) The Attorney General has determined that the firearm laws of the state are similar to the firearm laws of this Commonwealth.]
