AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for
- 3 assault of law enforcement officer.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2702.1(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2702.1. Assault of law enforcement officer.
- 9 (a) Assault of a law enforcement officer in the first
- 10 degree. -- A person commits a felony of the first degree [who
- 11 attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes bodily
- 12 injury] if, with respect to a law enforcement officer[,] while
- 13 in the performance of duty and with knowledge that the victim is
- 14 a law enforcement officer, [by discharging a firearm.] the
- 15 person attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly causes:
- (1) bodily injury by discharging a firearm; or
- 17 (2) serious bodily injury by use of a deadly weapon as

- defined in section 2301 (relating to definitions).

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
