AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for powers and duties of
- commission; and establishing the Antlerless Deer Harvest
- 4 Committee.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 322(a) and (c)(13) of Title 34 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 322. Powers and duties of commission.
- 10 (a) Duties.--It shall be the duty of the commission to
- 11 protect, propagate, manage and preserve the game or wildlife of
- 12 this Commonwealth and to enforce, by proper actions and
- 13 proceedings, the laws of this Commonwealth relating thereto. In
- 14 <u>fulfilling this duty</u>, the commission shall focus primarily on
- 15 <u>serving the interest of sportsmen and preserving and promoting</u>
- 16 this Commonwealth's special heritage of recreational hunting and
- 17 furtaking.
- 18 * * *
- 19 (c) Specific powers and duties. -- In order to administrate

- 1 and enforce this title, the commission through proper action
- 2 shall:
- 3 * * *
- 4 (13) Serve the interest of sportsmen by preserving and
- 5 promoting [our] this Commonwealth's special heritage of
- 6 recreational hunting and furtaking by maximizing the
- 7 <u>sustainable harvest of the whitetail deer herd and providing</u>
- 8 adequate opportunity to hunt and trap the wildlife resources
- 9 of this Commonwealth.
- 10 Section 2. Title 34 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 11 § 2315. Antlerless Deer Harvest Committee.
- 12 (a) Establishment.--The Antlerless Deer Harvest Committee is
- 13 <u>established</u>.
- 14 (b) Composition. -- The committee shall consist of licensed
- 15 hunters. One member shall be appointed by each of the following:
- 16 <u>(1) The Board of Commissioners of the commission.</u>
- 17 (2) The President pro tempore of the Senate.
- 18 (3) The Minority Leader of the Senate.
- 19 <u>(4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.</u>
- 20 (5) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
- 21 (c) Restriction. -- No member of the commission may be
- 22 appointed to the committee.
- 23 <u>(d) Term.--</u>
- 24 (1) The member appointed under subsection (b) (1) shall
- 25 serve an initial term of four years.
- 26 (2) The members appointed under subsection (b) (2) and
- 27 <u>(5) shall each serve an initial term of three years.</u>
- 28 (3) The members appointed under subsection (b) (3) and
- 29 (4) shall each serve an initial term of two years.
- 30 (4) Upon expiration of the terms under paragraphs (1),

- 1 (2) and (3), members shall serve terms of four years.
- 2 (e) Vacancies. -- A vacancy on the committee shall be filled
- 3 by the appointing authority for the balance of the term.
- 4 (f) Chair. -- The chair shall be elected annually by a
- 5 majority vote of the members of the committee.
- 6 (g) Duties. -- Notwithstanding any other law or regulation to
- 7 the contrary, the committee shall determine the total antlerless
- 8 <u>deer licenses allocated for each wildlife management unit. In</u>
- 9 making the determination, the committee shall do all of the
- 10 following:
- 11 (1) Receive the written allocation recommendations from
- the commission under subsection (i).
- 13 (2) Within 45 days of receipt of the recommendations
- 14 <u>under paragraph (1), accept or change the allocation</u>
- 15 recommendations for each management unit provided by the
- commission by a majority vote of the committee. If the
- 17 committee fails to act within 45 days of receipt of the
- 18 allocation recommendations, the allocation recommendation for
- 19 that management unit shall be deemed to be accepted by the
- 20 committee.
- 21 (h) Expenses.--Members of the committee shall receive no
- 22 compensation for their services but shall receive reimbursement
- 23 for necessary and proper expenses for attendance at meetings.
- 24 (i) Duties of commission. -- The commission shall:
- 25 (1) Provide to the committee written allocation
- 26 recommendations for antlerless deer license allocations for
- 27 <u>each management unit for the upcoming hunting season by April</u>
- 28 1 of each year.
- 29 (2) Provide or produce any data or study requested by
- 30 the committee.

- 1 Section 3. The Antlerless Deer Harvest Committee shall be
- 2 established within 30 days of the effective date of this section
- 3 and shall determine antlerless deer license allocations
- 4 beginning with the 2016 antlerless deer hunting season.
- 5 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
