A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4 5	Petitioning the Congress of the United States to call a convention of states limited to proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States that impose fiscal restraints on the Federal Government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the Federal Government and limit the terms of office for its officials and for members of Congress.
7	WHEREAS, The Founding Fathers, in drafting the Constitution
8	of the United States, empowered state legislators to be
9	guardians of liberty against future abuses of power by the
10	Federal Government; and
11	WHEREAS, The Federal Government has created a crushing
12	national debt through improper and imprudent spending; and
13	WHEREAS, The Federal Government has invaded the legitimate
14	roles of the states through the manipulative process of Federal
15	mandates, most of which are unfunded to a great extent; and
16	WHEREAS, The Federal Government has ceased to operate under a
17	proper interpretation of the Constitution of the United States;

WHEREAS, It is the solemn duty of the states, in order to

- 1 protect the liberty of the people of this nation, particularly
- 2 for the generations to come, to propose amendments to the
- 3 Constitution of the United States through a convention of states
- 4 under Article V to place clear restraints on the abuses of power
- 5 described in this resolution and related abuses of power;
- 6 therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 8 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania petition, under the
- 9 provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United
- 10 States, the Congress of the United States to call a convention
- 11 of states limited to proposing amendments to the Constitution of
- 12 the United States that impose fiscal restraints on the Federal
- 13 Government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the Federal
- 14 Government and limit the terms of office for its officials and
- 15 for members of Congress; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That this resolution constitute a continuing
- 17 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of
- 18 the United States until at least two-thirds of the legislatures
- 19 of the several states have made application for a convention on
- 20 the same subject; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this resolution be
- 22 transmitted by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to the
- 23 President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United
- 24 States House of Representatives, each member of the Pennsylvania
- 25 delegation to Congress and to the presiding officers of each
- 26 house of the state legislatures, requesting their cooperation in
- 27 applying for an amendments convention limited to the subject
- 28 matter contemplated by this application.
