AN ACT

Making a supplemental appropriation from the General Fund to the Department of Corrections for the purpose of state correctional institutions for the fiscal year July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Appropriation.
For fiscal year 2015-2016, the sum of $\$ 939,401,000$ is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of

Corrections for the purpose of State correctional institutions.
This appropriation shall be a supplemental appropriation and shall be in addition to the appropriation contained in the act of December 29, 2015 (P.L. , No.10A), known as the General Appropriation Act of 2015, vetoed in part.

Section 2. Deduction of expenditures under temporary expenditure symbols and prior law.

Any money that has been expended under temporary expenditure symbols approved by the Office of the Budget and paid after June

10 of that date.
11 Section 4. Retroactivity.
This act shall apply retroactively to July 1, 2015. Section 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
