- Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in Pennsylvania Game Commission, further providing 2
- for junior hunter projects; and, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further providing for unlawful acts concerning 3

- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 327 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania 8
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is repealed:
- 10 [§ 327. Junior hunter projects.
- 11 (a) General rule. -- It shall be the duty of the commission to
- initiate, implement and administer two or more junior license 12
- hunter projects for the purpose of increasing and sustaining 13
- 14 interest in hunting among young persons of this Commonwealth.
- 15 Except for the requirement to actually hold a junior hunting
- 16 license under section 2705(2) or (9) (relating to classes of
- licenses) and as may otherwise be modified by commission 17
- regulations, all participants in any junior hunter project shall 18

- 1 comply with all of the provisions of this title and the
- 2 regulations promulgated hereunder.
- 3 (b) Specific projects.--
- 4 (1) One of the projects shall consist of at least two
- free hunting days for persons qualified to receive a junior
- 6 hunting license under section 2705(2) or (9) and who have
- 7 successfully completed the hunter education requirements
- 8 under section 2704(b) (relating to eligibility for license).
- 9 The commission shall establish the days, times and species
- 10 which may be taken during the free hunting days.
- 11 (2) One of the projects shall consist of a Pennsylvania
- Game Commission program subject to the review of both the
- Game and Fisheries Committee of the House of Representatives
- 14 and the Game and Fisheries Committee of the Senate. The
- respective committees shall have 60 days to review the
- program and submit comments to the commission. Prior to
- 17 completion of the review by the respective committees, the
- 18 commission shall not take any action to initiate the
- 19 program.]
- 20 Section 2. Section 2711(a.1) of Title 34 is amended to read:
- 21 § 2711. Unlawful acts concerning licenses.
- 22 * * *
- 23 (a.1) Exemption. -- For the sole purpose of implementing and
- 24 enhancing a mentored hunting program within this Commonwealth,
- 25 the commission [may] shall establish regulations exempting
- 26 certain limited hunting activities from the prohibitions
- 27 specified in subsection (a)(1), (3), (5) and (8). Such exemption
- 28 shall include a provision limiting a mentored person
- 29 participating in a mentored hunting program to the receipt of no
- 30 more than one antlerless deer license in each license year. A

- 1 person [17] 12 years of age or older may participate in a
- 2 mentored hunting program as a mentored hunter in no more than
- 3 three licensing years.

- 5 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
