## AN ACT

Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking, further providing for 1 2 unlawful devices and methods. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2308(a)(2) and (3) of Title 34 of the 6 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 2308. Unlawful devices and methods. 8 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in this 9 10 title, it is unlawful for any person to hunt or aid, abet, 11 assist or conspire to hunt any game or wildlife through the use 12 of: 13 14 (2) A semiautomatic [rifle or] pistol. 15 [(Reserved).] <u>A semiautomatic centerfire rifle</u>, unless the semiautomatic centerfire rifle is limited to a 16 five-shell capacity, not including the rifle's chamber. This 17 paragraph includes a semiautomatic rimfire rifle in .22 18

- 1 <u>caliber without an ammunition capacity limit.</u>

- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
