AN ACT

- Protecting from infringement the individual right of the 1 citizens of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to bear arms as 2 provided in section 21 of Article I of the Constitution of 3 Pennsylvania. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 7 Section 1. Findings. The General Assembly finds and declares that: 8 9 The Constitution of Pennsylvania, and its protection of the right to bear arms, predate the Constitution of the 10 11 United States. 12 It is an established canon of judicial construction 1.3 that a state constitution may not offer less protection of 14 individual rights than the Constitution of the United States, 15 but it can afford more protections.
- 16 (3) Section 21 of Article I of the Constitution of
 17 Pennsylvania provides: "The right of the citizens to bear
 18 arms in defense of themselves and the State shall not be

- 1 questioned."
- 2 (4) Pennsylvania's constitutional protection of an
- 3 individual's right to bear arms is clear and unequivocal.
- 4 Section 2. Use of State resources to enforce Federal laws
- 5 relating to firearms, firearm components or
- 6 ammunition.
- 7 (a) General rule. -- Neither the Commonwealth, nor any of its
- 8 political subdivisions, shall allow the use of any resources or
- 9 public funds to enforce any Federal law, executive order or
- 10 regulation that is enacted or promulgated after the effective
- 11 date of this section and attempts to register, restrict or ban
- 12 the ownership or purchase, whether by number or type, of a
- 13 firearm, component of a firearm or ammunition.
- 14 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term
- 15 "resources" shall mean and include judicial buildings,
- 16 correctional facilities, personnel and equipment.
- 17 Section 3. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect immediately.
