## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in hunting and furtaking, further providing for
- killing game or wildlife by mistake; and, in hunting and
- furtaking licenses, further providing for period of
- 5 revocation.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 2306(a) and (b) of Title 34 of the
- 9 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 10 § 2306. Killing game or wildlife by mistake.
- 11 (a) General rule. -- Any person who, while hunting or trapping
- 12 for game or wildlife which may be lawfully taken, by accident or
- 13 mistake kills or attempts to kill any game or wildlife other
- 14 than [bears, elk or] threatened or endangered species, contrary
- 15 to the provisions of this title, shall pay restitution pursuant
- 16 to subsection (b) to an officer of the commission.
- 17 (b) Restitution.--Restitution for killing or an attempted
- 18 killing by accident or mistake shall be as follows:
- 19 (1) Each deer \$25.

- 1 (2) Each turkey \$20.
- 2 (3) Each other wild bird or wild animal, other than [a
- 3 bear, elk or] an endangered or threatened species \$15.
- 4 <u>(4) Each bear \$100.</u>
- (5) Each elk \$100.

- 7 Section 2. Section 2742 of Title 34 is amended by adding a
- 8 subsection to read:
- 9 § 2742. Period of revocation.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (c) Clemency from revocation. -- The commission shall not
- 12 revoke the privilege to hunt or take game or wildlife anywhere
- 13 <u>in this Commonwealth for an unlawful taking or possession of</u>
- 14 game or wildlife violation if all of the following conditions
- 15 are met:
- 16 (1) The unlawful taking or possession of game or
- wildlife violation is the person's first unlawful taking or
- 18 possession of game or wildlife offense.
- 19 (2) The person complies with all of the procedural
- requirements set forth in section 2306(b)(1), (2) or (3)
- 21 (relating to killing game or wildlife by mistake) concerning
- 22 removal of entrails, tagging, reporting, delivery of carcass
- and providing a written, sworn statement.
- 24 (3) The unlawful taking of game or wildlife violation
- 25 occurs during:
- 26 (i) an open season within the applicable wildlife
- 27 <u>management unit for the species involved; or</u>
- 28 (ii) a closed season within the applicable wildlife
- 29 <u>management unit for the species involved, but only if</u>
- there was an open season within an adjacent wildlife

2	(4) The person pleads guilty to the applicable unlawful
3	taking or possession of game or wildlife violation charged.
4	(5) The unlawful taking or possession of game or
5	wildlife violation does not involve a threatened or
6	endangered species.

8	present concerning the unlawful taking or possession of game
