## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in hunting and furtaking, further providing for the
- offense of dogs pursuing, injuring or killing big game.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2383 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2383. Dogs pursuing, injuring or killing big game.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- Except as provided in subsection (b), it
- 10 is unlawful for any person to make use of a dog in any manner to
- 11 hunt for or to take big game or to permit a dog owned,
- 12 controlled or harbored by that person to pursue, harass, chase,
- 13 scatter, injure or make use of a dog to kill any big game.
- 14 (b) Exception.--It shall be lawful to [make] do any of the
- 15 following:
- 16 (1) Make use of a dog to pursue, chase, scatter and
- 17 track wild turkeys during the fall wild turkey season.

- 1 (2) Make use of a leashed blood-tracking dog to track a
- 2 white-tailed deer, bear or elk in an attempt to recover an
- 3 <u>animal which has been legally killed or wounded during any</u>
- 4 <u>open season for white-tailed deer, bear or elk.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
