## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic 1 Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the offense of stalking; in wiretapping and electronic surveillance, further providing for definitions; 5 in domestic and sexual violence victim address 6 confidentiality, further providing for penalties; and, in 7 sentencing, further providing for sentences for second and subsequent offenses. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. - (iv) Retaliation against witness, victim or party as defined in section 4953(a) and (b) (relating to retaliation against witness, victim or party).
- (v) Criminal attempt as defined in section 901(a) (relating to criminal attempt), criminal solicitation as defined in section 902(a) (relating to criminal solicitation) or criminal conspiracy as defined in section 903(a) (relating to criminal conspiracy) to commit any of the offenses specified in this definition.
- (2) Any offense equivalent to an offense under paragraph
  (1) under the laws of this Commonwealth in effect at the time
  of the commission of that offense or under the laws of
