AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, providing for liability insurance for firearms.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6128. Liability insurance for firearms.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A person who owns a firearm shall obtain
- 10 and continuously maintain a policy of liability insurance in an
- 11 <u>amount not less than \$100,000 specifically covering any damages</u>
- 12 that result from any acts involving the use of the firearm while
- 13 the firearm is owned by the person.
- 14 <u>(b) Current firearm owners.--Within</u> 30 days of the effective
- 15 date of this subsection, a person who owns a firearm shall
- 16 obtain the liability insurance required under subsection (a).
- 17 (c) Loss or theft of firearm. -- For purposes of this section,
- 18 <u>a person shall be deemed to be the owner of a firearm if the</u>
- 19 firearm is lost or stolen until such time as the loss or theft

- 1 <u>is reported to the municipal police of the jurisdiction in which</u>
- 2 the loss or theft is believed to have occurred or the
- 3 Pennsylvania State Police.
- 4 (d) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a
- 5 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
- 6 <u>a fine not exceeding \$300 or to imprisonment for not more than</u>
- 7 <u>90 days.</u>
- 8 (e) Applicability. -- This section does not apply to a law
- 9 <u>enforcement officer authorized to carry a firearm.</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
