8	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
10	§ 6110.3. Purchase and sale of firearm parts without a serial

12	(a) General ruleA person who sells or, with the purpose
13	to manufacture or otherwise assemble a firearm and without being
14	registered or licensed to do so under 18 U.S.C. § 923(a)
15	(relating to licensing), purchases or otherwise obtains
16	separately or as part of a kit a firearm frame or firearm
17	receiver which is not imprinted with a serial number registered
18	with a federally licensed manufacturer or any combination of

- 1 parts from which a firearm without a serial number may be
- 2 readily or otherwise assembled, but which does not have the
- 3 capacity to function as a firearm unless manufactured or
- 4 otherwise assembled, commits a felony of the second degree.
- 5 (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 6 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 7 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 8 <u>"Firearm frame or firearm receiver." The part of a firearm</u>
- 9 that provides housing for the firearm's internal components,
- 10 such as the hammer, bolt or breechblock, action and firing
- 11 mechanism, and includes, without limitation, any object or part
- 12 which is not such part in finished form but is designed or
- 13 <u>intended to be used for that purpose and which may readily have</u>
- 14 been made into such part or recovered through milling or other
- 15 means.
- 16 § 6110.4. Manufacturing or facilitating the manufacture of
- 17 firearm using three-dimensional printer.
- 18 (a) General rule. -- No person may:
- 19 (1) use a three-dimensional printer or similar device to
- 20 manufacture or produce a firearm receiver, magazine or
- 21 <u>firearm component; or</u>
- 22 (2) distribute by any means, including the Internet, to
- 23 <u>a person in Pennsylvania digital instructions in the form of</u>
- computer-aided design files or other code or instructions
- 25 stored and displayed in electronic format as a digital model
- that may be used to program a three-dimensional printer to
- 27 manufacture or produce a firearm or any firearm component.
- 28 (b) Penalty.--A person who violates this section commits a
- 29 felony of the second degree.
- 30 (c) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following

- 1 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 2 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 3 "Distribute." To sell or to manufacture, give, provide,
- 4 <u>lend, trade, mail, deliver, publish, circulate, disseminate,</u>
- 5 present, exhibit, display, share, advertise, offer or make
- 6 <u>available via the Internet or by any other means, whether for</u>
- 7 pecuniary gain or not, and includes an agreement or attempt to
- 8 engage in such activity.
- 9 "Firearm component." A part or parts used separately or as
- 10 part of a kit which do not have the capacity to function as a
- 11 <u>firearm unless assembled with a firearm frame or firearm</u>
- 12 receiver.
- "Firearm frame or firearm receiver." As defined in section
- 14 <u>6110.3.</u>
- 15 <u>"Three-dimensional printer." A computer or computer-driven</u>
- 16 <u>machine or device capable of producing a three-dimensional</u>
- 17 object from a digital model.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
