## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
- articles, providing for report of theft or loss of firearm.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6115.1. Report of theft or loss of firearm.
- 9 (a) Duty to report. -- An owner or other person lawfully in
- 10 possession of a firearm who suffers the loss or theft of a
- 11 firearm shall within 24 hours of the discovery of the loss or
- 12 theft report the facts and circumstances of the loss or theft to
- 13 the police department having jurisdiction where the loss or
- 14 theft occurred. The person making the report shall provide the
- 15 <u>following information:</u>
- 16 (1) Name and permanent address of the owner.
- 17 (2) Name of the manufacturer and importer, if
- 18 applicable.

- 1 <u>(3) Model.</u>
- 2 (4) Type of action.
- 3 <u>(5) Caliber or gauge.</u>
- 4 <u>(6) Serial number.</u>
- 5 (7) Any other information deemed necessary by the
- 6 <u>officer or police department receiving the report.</u>
- 7 (b) Sharing of information. -- When a person reports the loss
- 8 or theft of a firearm to a police department, the officer or
- 9 <u>department receiving the report shall forward notice of the loss</u>
- 10 or theft with the information obtained under subsection (a) to
- 11 <u>the Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
- 12 <u>(c) Pennsylvania State Police.--The Pennsylvania State</u>
- 13 Police shall receive, collect and file the information forwarded
- 14 to it under subsection (a). The Pennsylvania State Police shall
- 15 cooperate, and undertake to furnish or make the information
- 16 <u>available to all law enforcement agencies in this Commonwealth</u>,
- 17 for the purpose of coordinating law enforcement efforts to
- 18 locate the firearms.
- (d) Penalty. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- 20 person who violates subsection (a) commits a summary offense
- 21 punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
