## AN ACT

Amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 35 (Health and 1 Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in 2 firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for 3 prohibited conduct during emergency; and, in Commonwealth services, further providing for general authority of Governor. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 6107(a) and (b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 10 11 § 6107. Prohibited conduct during emergency. 12 [(a) General rule. -- No person shall carry a firearm upon the public streets or upon any public property during an emergency 13 14 proclaimed by a State or municipal governmental executive unless that person is: 15 16 Actively engaged in a defense of that person's life 17 or property from peril or threat. Licensed to carry firearms under section 6109 18 (2) 19 (relating to licenses) or is exempt from licensing under

- section 6106(b) (relating to firearms not to be carried
- without a license).]
- 3 (b) Seizure, taking and confiscation.--[Except as otherwise
- 4 provided under subsection (a) and notwithstanding]
- 5 Notwithstanding the provisions of 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 73 (relating to

- 7 contrary, no firearm, accessory or ammunition may be seized,
