- 6 Section 1. Section 2704 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- § 2704. Eligibility for license. 8

- 10 (q) Hunter education in public schools. -- Upon request of the
- 11 commission, all public school districts in this Commonwealth
- shall make a school facility under their control available for 12
- 13 the purpose of conducting a hunter education course. Classes may
- 14 occur as an after-school or weekend function or any other day
- 15 when school is not in session. The commission shall, to the best
- 16 of its ability, work with the school to schedule classes for a
- time that best suits both the school and the commission. All 17
- classes shall comply with curriculum standards and program 18

- 1 policies established by the director. The commission shall
- 2 <u>compensate the school for the actual cost incurred by the school</u>
- 3 related to the commission's use of the facility. Fees may not be
- 4 charged to the public for the service under this section.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
