7	Section 1. Short title.
8	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Communication-<
9	of Older Adult Abuse ROBERT RAPH Act. <
10	Section 2. Definitions.
11	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
12	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
13	context clearly indicates otherwise:
14	"Abuse." The occurrence of one or more of the following acts <
15	committed against an older adult:
16	(1) The infliction of injury, unreasonable confinement,
17	intimidation or punishment resulting in physical harm, pain-

1 or mental anguish. 2 (2) The willful deprivation by a caretaker of goods or 3 services that are necessary to maintain physical or mental health. 4 5 (3) Sexual abuse, including any of the following acts: 6 (i) Rape. 7 (ii) Involuntary deviate sexual intercourse. 8 (iii) Sexual assault. 9 (iv) Aggravated indecent assault. (v) Indecent assault. 10 (vi) Incest. 11 (4) Sexual harassment, including any of the following-12 13 acts: 14 (i) Unwelcome sexual advances. 15 (ii) Requests for sexual favors. 16 (iii) Other unwelcome verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature. 17 18 "ABUSE." EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING: <---19 (1) AS DEFINED IN SECTION 103 OF THE ACT OF NOVEMBER 6, 20 1987 (P.L.381, NO.79), KNOWN AS THE OLDER ADULTS PROTECTIVE 21 SERVICES ACT; OR 22 (2) AS DEFINED IN SECTION 103 OF THE ACT OF OCTOBER 7, 23 2010 (P.L.484, NO.70), KNOWN AS THE ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES 24 ACT. 25 "ADULT." AS DEFINED IN SECTION 103 OF THE ADULT PROTECTIVE 26 SERVICES ACT. 27 "Facility." 1 (2) A hospice as defined in section 802.1 of the Health 2 Care Facilities Act. A personal care home as defined in section 1001 of 3 (3) the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human 4 5 Services Code. An assisted living residence as defined in section 6 (4) 1001 of the Human Services Code. 7 "Older adult." An individual within the jurisdiction of this <--8 Commonwealth who is 60 years of age or older. 9 "OLDER ADULT." AS DEFINED IN SECTION 103 OF THE OLDER ADULTS <--10 PROTECTIVE SERVICES ACT. 11 Section 3. Communication duties of departments. 12 13 (a) General rule.--If an allegation of abuse at a facility <--14 is reported to the Department of Health or the Department of 15 Human Services, the Department of Health or the Department of Human Services shall report the allegation of abuse to the older-16 adult's local area agency on aging and the Department of Aging-17 18 within 24 hours. 19 (b) Investigation.---20 (1) Upon receipt of an allegation of abuse under 21 subsection (a), the local area agency on aging shall conduct 22 an investigation of the allegation of abuse as required undersection 303 of the act of November 6, 1987 (P.L.381, No.79), 23 24 known as the Older Adults Protective Services Act. 25 (2) The Department of Health or the Department of Human 26 Services shall provide all necessary information to the older-27 adult's local area agency on aging and the Department of-28 Aging to aid in an investigation of alleged abuse reported 29 under this section. (c) Regulations. The Department of Health and the 30

4 (A) ALLEGATIONS INVOLVING OLDER ADULTS.--WHEN AN ALLEGATION <--
5 OF ABUSE INVOLVING AN OLDER ADULT RESIDING IN A FACILITY IS
6 REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
7 SERVICES, THE DEPARTMENT THAT RECEIVED THE ALLEGATION SHALL:

8 (1) REFER THE ALLEGATION TO THE LOCAL AREA AGENCY ON 9 AGING FOR SCREENING AND INVESTIGATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 10 ACT OF NOVEMBER 6, 1987 (P.L.381, NO.79), KNOWN AS THE OLDER 11 ADULTS PROTECTIVE SERVICES ACT.

12 (2) PROVIDE ALL INFORMATION RELATED TO THE ALLEGATION TO
13 THE LOCAL AREA AGENCY ON AGING TO AID IN THE INVESTIGATION OF
14 ALLEGED ABUSE.

(B) ALLEGATIONS INVOLVING ADULTS.--WHEN AN ALLEGATION OF
ABUSE INVOLVING AN ADULT RESIDING IN A FACILITY IS REPORTED TO
EITHER THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
SERVICES, THE DEPARTMENT THAT RECEIVED THE ALLEGATION SHALL:

(1) REFER THE ALLEGATION TO THE AGENCY FOR SCREENING AND
INVESTIGATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACT OF OCTOBER 7, 2010
(P.L.484, NO.70), KNOWN AS THE ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES ACT.

(2) PROVIDE ALL INFORMATION RELATED TO THE ALLEGATION TOTHE AGENCY TO AID IN THE INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED ABUSE.

24 (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE TERM "AGENCY"
25 SHALL HAVE THE MEANING GIVEN TO IT IN SECTION 103 OF THE
26 ADULT PROTECTIVE SERVICES ACT.

(C) ONGOING COMMUNICATION.--THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, THE
DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF AGING SHALL
ESTABLISH ONGOING COMMUNICATION TO DETERMINE THE MOST EFFECTIVE
AND EFFICIENT MANNER IN WHICH THE INFORMATION UNDER THIS SECTION
