## AN ACT

6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 6115.1. Civil liability of firearm owner for loss or theft.</u>
10	(a) Duty to reportAn owner or other person lawfully in
11	possession of a firearm who suffers the loss or theft of a
12	firearm shall, within 24 hours of the discovery of the loss or
13	theft, report the loss or theft, including the facts and
14	circumstances of the loss or theft, to the municipal police of
15	the jurisdiction in which the loss or theft is believed to have
16	occurred or to the Pennsylvania State Police.
17	(b) PenaltyNotwithstanding any other provision of law, a
18	person who fails to report the loss or theft of a firearm under

- 1 <u>subsection (a) and the failure to report is a proximate cause of</u>
- 2 the commission of a crime in which the firearm is later used may
- 3 be held civilly liable for any damages resulting from that
- 4 <u>crime.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
