## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 2 3 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 7 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," in ballots, further providing for form of 11 official primary ballot and for form of official election 12 13 ballot. 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Sections 1002(b) and 1003(d) of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election 17 18 Code, are amended to read: 19 Section 1002. Form of Official Primary Ballot .--\* \* \* 20 On the back of each ballot shall be printed in prominent 21 type the words "OFFICIAL PRIMARY BALLOT OF ......PARTY FOR" followed by the designation of the election district for which 22 it is prepared, the date of the primary and the facsimile 23

- 1 signatures of the members of the county board of elections. The
- 2 names of candidates shall in all cases be arranged under the
- 3 title of the office for which they are candidates, and be
- 4 printed thereunder in the order determined by the casting of
- 5 lots as provided by this act. Under the title of such offices
- 6 where more than one candidate is to be voted for, shall be
- 7 printed "Vote for not more than ....." (the blank space to
- 8 indicate the number of candidates to be voted for the particular
- 9 office.) At the right of the name of each candidate there shall
- 10 be a square of sufficient size for the convenient insertion of a
- 11 cross (x) or check ( $\checkmark$ ) mark. There shall be left at the end of
- 12 the list of candidates for each office (or under the title of
- 13 the office itself in case there be no candidates who have filed
- 14 nomination petitions therefor) as many blank spaces as there are
- 15 persons to be voted for, for such office, in which space the
- 16 elector may insert, by writing or stamping, the name of any
- 17 person whose name is not printed on the ballot as a candidate
- 18 for such office. Opposite or under the name of each candidate,
- 19 except candidates for the office of President of the United
- 20 States and candidates for delegate or alternate delegate to a
- 21 National Party Convention, who is to be voted for by the
- 22 electors of more than one county, shall be printed the name of
- 23 the county in which such candidate resides; and opposite or
- 24 under the name of each candidate except candidates for delegate
- 25 or alternate delegate to a National Party Convention who is to
- 26 be voted for by the electors of an entire county or any
- 27 congressional, senatorial or representative district within the
- 28 county, shall be printed the name of the city, borough, township
- 29 or ward, as the case may be, in which such candidate resides. <u>If</u>
- 30 <u>a candidate runs for more than one nomination for the same</u>

- 1 office, opposite or under the name of that candidate shall be
- 2 printed "Running as ....." (the blank space to indicate the
- 3 party for which that primary ballot is prepared); and opposite
- 4 or under the name of that candidate shall be printed either
- 5 "Registered ....." (the blank space to indicate the party of
- 6 which the candidate is a registered and enrolled member as
- 7 provided on the candidate's Pennsylvania voter registration
- 8 <u>application</u>) or, as the case may be, "Registered 'None/No Party
- 9 Affiliation'" to indicate that the candidate has no party
- 10 affiliation as provided on the candidate's voter registration
- 11 <u>application</u>.

- 13 Section 1003. Form of Official Election Ballot .--
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 (d) Whenever any candidate shall receive more than one
- 16 nomination for the same office, his name shall be printed once,
- 17 and the names of each political party so nominating him shall be
- 18 printed opposite the name of such candidate, arranged in the
- 19 same order as candidates names are required to be arranged.
- 20 <u>Under the name of each political party so nominating the</u>
- 21 <u>candidate shall be printed either "Registered ....." (the</u>
- 22 blank space to indicate the party of which the candidate is a
- 23 registered and enrolled member as provided on the candidate's
- 24 Pennsylvania voter registration application) or, as the case may
- 25 be, "Registered 'None/No Party Affiliation'" to indicate that
- 26 the candidate has no party affiliation as provided on the
- 27 <u>candidate's voter registration application.</u> At the right of all
- 28 the party names or appellation shall be a single square of
- 29 sufficient size for the convenient insertion of a cross (X) or
- 30 check ( $\checkmark$ ) mark.

- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
