1 2 3 4	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, providing for report of theft or loss of firearm; and imposing a penalty.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 6115.1. Report of theft or loss of firearm.</u>
10	(a) Duty to reportAn owner or other person lawfully in
11	possession of a firearm who suffers the loss or theft of a
12	firearm shall within 24 hours of the discovery of the loss or
13	theft report the facts and circumstances of the loss or theft to
14	the police department having jurisdiction where the loss or
15	theft occurred. The person making the report shall provide the
16	following information:
17	(1) Name and permanent address of the owner.
18	(2) Name of the manufacturer and importer, if

1	applicable.
2	<u>(3) Model.</u>
3	(4) Type of action.
4	(5) Caliber or gauge.
5	(6) Serial number.
6	(7) Any other information deemed necessary by the
7	officer or police department receiving the report.
8	(b) Sharing of informationWhen a person reports the loss
9	or theft of a firearm to a police department, the officer or
10	department receiving the report shall forward notice of the loss
11	or theft with the information obtained under subsection (a) to
12	<u>the Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
13	<u>(c) Pennsylvania State PoliceThe Pennsylvania State</u>
14	Police shall receive, collect and file the information forwarded
15	to it under subsection (a). The Pennsylvania State Police shall
16	cooperate with and undertake to furnish or make the information
17	available to all law enforcement agencies in this Commonwealth
18	for the purpose of coordinating law enforcement efforts to
19	locate the firearms.
20	(d) PenaltyNotwithstanding any other provision of law, a
21	person who violates subsection (a) commits a summary offense
22	punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.
23	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
