A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for exemptions and special
- 3 provisions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 2(c) of Article VIII be amended to read:
- 9 § 2. Exemptions and special provisions.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (c) Citizens and residents of this Commonwealth, who [served
- 12 in any war or armed conflict in which the United States was
- 13 engaged and were honorably discharged or released under
- 14 honorable circumstances from active service,]:
- 15 (i) Served as a member of the armed forces of the United
- 16 States, including a reserve component or National Guard, and who

- 1 were discharged or released from active service under conditions
- 2 <u>other than dishonorable</u>, shall be exempt from the payment of all
- 3 real property taxes upon the <u>primary</u> residence [occupied] <u>owned</u>
- 4 by the said citizens and residents of this Commonwealth imposed
- 5 by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its political
- 6 subdivisions if, as a result of [military] the member's service,
- 7 they are blind, paraplegic or double or quadruple amputees or
- 8 have a service-connected disability [declared] rated as 100%
- 9 permanent and totally disabled or compensated at the 100%
- 10 disability rate through the Individual Unemployability Program
- 11 or its successor program by the United States [Veterans
- 12 Administration] <u>Department of Veterans Affairs</u> or its successor
- 13 [to be a total or 100% permanent disability], and if the State
- 14 Veterans' Commission determines that such persons are in need of
- 15 the tax exemptions [granted herein.] <u>based on the economic</u>
- 16 circumstances that exist at the member's place of residence. The
- 17 exemption shall apply to the primary residence, even if the
- 18 eligible veteran resides at a long-term care facility, until the
- 19 eliqible veteran no longer retains ownership of the residence.
- 20 This exemption shall be extended to the unmarried surviving
- 21 spouse upon the death of [an eligible veteran] the person
- 22 <u>determined by the State Veterans' Commission to be eliqible</u>
- 23 provided that the State Veterans' Commission determines that
- 24 such person [is in need of] meets the need requirements for the
- 25 exemption. The State Veterans' Commission shall establish rules,
- 26 regulations and guidelines for making determinations of need.
- 27 (ii) Are the unmarried surviving spouse of any member of the
- 28 <u>armed forces of the United States, including a reserve component</u>
- 29 or National Guard, who died in the line of duty, died as a
- 30 result of injuries received in the line of duty, is presumed

- 1 <u>dead in a written finding or is posthumously determined to be</u>
- 2 100% permanent and totally disabled by the United States
- 3 Department of Defense, the United States Department of Veterans
- 4 Affairs or their successors, shall be exempt from the payment of
- 5 <u>all real property taxes on the surviving spouse's primary place</u>
- 6 of residence in this Commonwealth, without any restriction on
- 7 the surviving spouse's relocating to another primary place of
- 8 residence in this Commonwealth and without any requirement that
- 9 the surviving spouse reside in this Commonwealth at the time of
- 10 death or presumed dead status of the member of the armed forces,
- 11 <u>including a reserve component or National Guard, provided that</u>
- 12 the State Veterans' Commission determines that the surviving
- 13 spouse is in need of the exemption based on the economic
- 14 <u>circumstances that exist at the surviving spouse's place of</u>
- 15 residence in this Commonwealth. The State Veterans' Commission
- 16 <u>shall establish rules</u>, <u>regulations and guidelines for making</u>
- 17 determinations of need. The exemption shall cease if the
- 18 surviving spouse remarries and shall not be claimed thereafter.
- 19 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 20 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:
- 21 (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of
- the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 23 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- of Pennsylvania.
- 26 (2) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of
- 27 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall
- 28 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising
- requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution
- 30 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall

- submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this
- 2 Commonwealth at the first general or municipal election which
- 3 meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 4 Constitution of Pennsylvania.
