AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
 Consolidated Statutes, in sexual offenses, further providing
 for the offense of unlawful dissemination of intimate image;
 and, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual
 abuse of children and for the offense of transmission of
 sexually explicit images by minor.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 3131(a) and (c) of Title 18 of the
- 10 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and subsection
- 11 (g) is amended by adding definitions to read:
- 12 § 3131. Unlawful dissemination of intimate image.
- 13 (a) Offense defined.--Except as provided in sections 5903
- 14 (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and
- 15 performances), 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children) and
- 16 6321 (relating to transmission of sexually explicit images by
- 17 minor), a person commits the offense of unlawful dissemination
- 18 of intimate image if, with intent to harass, annoy or alarm a
- 19 current or former sexual or intimate partner, the person

- 1 disseminates [a visual depiction of the current or former sexual
- 2 or intimate partner in a state of nudity or engaged in sexual
- 3 conduct.]:
- 4 <u>(1) A visual depiction of the current or former sexual</u>
- 5 <u>or intimate partner in a state of nudity or engaged in sexual</u>
- 6 conduct.
- 7 (2) An artificially generated depiction of an
- 8 <u>individual</u>, with intent to harass, annoy or alarm an
- 9 <u>individual.</u>
- 10 * * *
- 11 (c) Grading.--[An offense under subsection (a) shall be:]
- 12 (1) An offense under subsection (a) (1) shall be:
- 13 [(1)] (i) A misdemeanor of the first degree, when the person depicted is a minor.
- 15 [(2)] <u>(ii)</u> A misdemeanor of the second degree, when the person depicted is not a minor.
- 17 (2) An offense under subsection (a) (2) shall be:
- 18 <u>(i) A felony of the third degree, when the person</u>
- depicted is a minor.
- 20 (ii) A misdemeanor of the first degree, when the
- 21 <u>person depicted is not a minor.</u>

- 23 (g) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 24 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 25 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 26 "Artificial intelligence." Any of the following:
- 27 <u>(1) An artificial system that performs tasks under</u>
- 28 varying and unpredictable circumstances without significant
- 29 <u>human oversight or that can learn from experience and improve</u>
- 30 performance when exposed to data sets.

- 1 (2) An artificial system developed in computer software,
- 2 <u>physical hardware or other context that solves tasks</u>
- 3 requiring human-like perception, cognition, planning,
- 4 <u>learning</u>, communication or physical action.
- 5 (3) An artificial system designed to think or act like a
- 6 <u>human, including cognitive architectures and neural networks.</u>
- 7 (4) A set of techniques, including machine learning,
- 8 that is designed to approximate a cognitive task.
- 9 <u>(5) An artificial system designed to act rationally,</u>
- 10 <u>including an intelligent software agent or embodied robot</u>
- 11 that achieves goals using perception, planning, reasoning,
- 12 <u>learning, communicating, decision making and acting.</u>
- "Artificially generated depiction." A visual depiction:
- 14 (1) that appears to authentically depict an individual
- in a state of nudity or engaged in sexual conduct that did
- 16 not occur in reality; and
- 17 (2) the production of which was substantially dependent
- 18 upon technical means, including artificial intelligence and
- 19 <u>photo editing software, rather than the ability of another</u>
- 20 person to physically impersonate the other person.

- 22 "Photo editing software." A software used primarily for
- 23 <u>editing photographs, videos or computer depictions that contains</u>
- 24 a variety of filters, effects or tools that can be used to
- 25 manipulate photographs, videos or computer depictions.

- 27 Section 2. Section 6312(c), (d), (f)(3) and (g) of Title 18
- 28 are amended to read:
- 29 § 6312. Sexual abuse of children.
- 30 * * *

- 1 (c) Dissemination of photographs, videotapes, computer
- 2 depictions and films. -- Any person who knowingly sells,
- 3 distributes, delivers, disseminates, transfers, displays or
- 4 exhibits to others, or who possesses for the purpose of sale,
- 5 distribution, delivery, dissemination, transfer, display or
- 6 exhibition to others, any <u>artificially generated depiction or</u>
- 7 book, magazine, pamphlet, slide, photograph, film, videotape,
- 8 computer depiction or other material depicting a child under the
- 9 age of 18 years engaging in a prohibited sexual act or in the
- 10 simulation of such act commits an offense.
- 11 (d) Child pornography. -- Any person who intentionally views
- 12 or knowingly possesses or controls any <u>artificially generated</u>
- 13 <u>depiction or</u> book, magazine, pamphlet, slide, photograph, film,
- 14 videotape, computer depiction or other material depicting a
- 15 child under the age of 18 years engaging in a prohibited sexual
- 16 act or in the simulation of such act commits an offense.

- 18 (f) Exceptions. -- This section does not apply to any of the
- 19 following:
- 20 * * *
- 21 (3) An individual under 18 years of age who knowingly
- views, photographs, videotapes, depicts on a computer or
- films or possesses or intentionally views a visual depiction
- as defined in section 6321 or an artificially generated
- 25 depiction of himself alone in a state of nudity as defined in
- 26 section 6321.

- 28 (g) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 29 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 30 subsection:

- 1 <u>"Artificial intelligence."</u> As defined in section 3131
- 2 (relating to unlawful dissemination of intimate image).
- 3 "Artificially generated depiction." A book, magazine,
- 4 pamphlet, slide, photograph, videotape, film or computer
- 5 <u>depiction:</u>
- 6 (1) that appears to authentically depict a child under
- 7 <u>18 years of age engaging in a prohibited sexual act or in the</u>
- 8 <u>simulation of such act that did not occur in reality; and</u>
- 9 (2) the production of which was substantially dependent
- 10 upon technical means, including artificial intelligence and
- 11 photo editing software, rather than the ability of another
- 12 <u>person to physically impersonate the child.</u>
- "Intentionally views." The deliberate, purposeful, voluntary
- 14 viewing of material containing an artificially generated
- 15 <u>depiction or</u> depicting a child under 18 years of age engaging in
- 16 a prohibited sexual act or in the simulation of such act. The
- 17 term shall not include the accidental or inadvertent viewing of
- 18 such material.
- 19 "Photo editing software." As defined in section 3131.
- 20 "Prohibited sexual act." Sexual intercourse as defined in
- 21 section 3101 (relating to definitions), masturbation, sadism,
- 22 masochism, bestiality, fellatio, cunnilingus, lewd exhibition of
- 23 the genitals or nudity if such nudity is depicted for the
- 24 purpose of sexual stimulation or gratification of any person who
- 25 might view such depiction.
- 26 Section 3. The definition of "sexually explicit image" in
- 27 section 6321(g) of Title 18 is amended and the subsection is
- 28 amended by adding definitions to read:
- 29 § 6321. Transmission of sexually explicit images by minor.
- 30 * * *

- 1 (g) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 2 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 3 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 4 <u>"Artificial intelligence."</u> As defined in section 3131
- 5 (relating to unlawful dissemination of intimate image).
- 6 "Artificially generated depiction." Any visual depiction:
- 7 (1) that appears to authentically depict a child under
- 8 <u>18 years of age engaged in conduct or an action or state of</u>
- 9 <u>nudity that did not occur in reality; and</u>
- 10 (2) the production of which was substantially dependent
- 11 upon technical means, including artificial intelligence and
- 12 <u>photo editing software, rather than the ability of another</u>
- person to physically impersonate the child.

- "Photo editing software." As defined in section 3131.
- 16 * * *
- "Sexually explicit image." A lewd or lascivious visual
- 18 depiction or artificially generated depiction of a minor's
- 19 genitals, pubic area, breast or buttocks or nudity, if such
- 20 nudity is depicted for the purpose of sexual stimulation or
- 21 gratification of any person who might view such nudity.

- 23 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
