## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Statutes, in hunting and furtaking, repealing provisions relating to hunting on Sunday prohibited, providing for hunting on Sunday and further providing FOR THE OFFENSE OF TRESPASS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WHILE HUNTING AND for hunting on Sunday without written permission.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 2303 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
10	Consolidated Statutes is repealed:
11	[§ 2303. Hunting on Sunday prohibited.
12	(a) General rule Except as otherwise provided in this
13	title, it is unlawful for any person to hunt for any furbearer
14	or game on Sunday.
15	(b) Construction of section This section shall not be
16	construed to prohibit:
17	(1) The training of dogs.
18	(2) The participation in dog trials as provided for in
19	this title.
20	(3) The removal of lawfully taken game or wildlife from

- traps or the resetting of the traps on Sunday.
- 2 (b.1) Exceptions. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply to:
- 3 (1) The hunting of foxes.
- 4 (2) The hunting of coyotes.
- 5 (3) Any hunting which occurs on noncommercial regulated
- 6 hunting grounds holding a valid permit under section 2928(b)
  - (2) (relating to regulated hunting grounds permits).

- 10 (i) One day of Sunday hunting shall be instituted by

- (ii) One day of Sunday hunting shall be instituted

- (iii) One day of Sunday hunting as determined by the

- Authority to hunt on any Sunday instituted by the commission
- under this paragraph shall not apply to any person required

- 21 THAT HAS BEEN PERSONALLY COMMUNICATED TO THE PERSON BY THE
- 22 OWNER OF THE LAND OR OTHER AUTHORIZED PERSON[.];
- 23 (3) ENTERS OR REMAINS ON ANY LAND OF ANOTHER WITHOUT
- 24 AUTHORIZATION TO DO SO, WHEN THE LAND IS FENCED OR ENCLOSED
- 25 IN A MANNER MANIFESTLY DESIGNED TO EXCLUDE TRESPASSERS; OR
- 26 (4) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B), ENTERS OR REMAINS ON ANY
- 27 LAND OF ANOTHER WITHOUT AUTHORIZATION TO DO SO WHEN NOTICE
- 28 AGAINST TRESPASS IS GIVEN BY THE PLACEMENT OF IDENTIFYING
- 29 PURPLE PAINT MARKS ON TREES OR POSTS ON THE PROPERTY, WHICH
- 30 ARE:

1	(I) VERTICAL LINES OF NOT LESS THAN EIGHT INCHES IN
2	LENGTH AND NOT LESS THAN ONE INCH IN WIDTH;
3	(II) PLACED IN A MANNER SO THAT THE BOTTOM OF THE
4	MARK IS NOT LESS THAN THREE FEET FROM THE GROUND AND NOT
5	MORE THAN FIVE FEET FROM THE GROUND; AND
6	(III) PLACED AT LOCATIONS THAT ARE READILY VISIBLE
7	TO A PERSON APPROACHING THE PROPERTY AND NO MORE THAN 100
8	FEET APART.
9	(B) APPLICABILITY
10	(1) THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO AN UNARMED PERSON
11	WHO ENTERS ONTO POSTED PROPERTY FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF
12	RETRIEVING A HUNTING DOG.
13	(2) SUBSECTION (A) (4) SHALL NOT APPLY IN A COUNTY OF THE
14	FIRST CLASS OR A COUNTY OF THE SECOND CLASS.
15	(C) PENALTY AN OFFENSE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE GRADED
16	AS FOLLOWS:
17	(1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) (1), (3) OR (4)
18	COMMITS A SUMMARY OFFENSE OF THE [THIRD DEGREE.] <u>SECOND</u>
19	DEGREE AND SHALL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE PRIVILEGE TO
20	HUNT OR TAKE GAME OR WILDLIFE ANYWHERE WITHIN THIS
21	COMMONWEALTH FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO ONE YEAR.
22	(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A)(2) COMMITS A
23	MISDEMEANOR[.] AND SHALL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE
24	PRIVILEGE TO HUNT OR TAKE GAME OR WILDLIFE ANYWHERE WITHIN
25	THIS COMMONWEALTH FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS.
26	(3) A PERSON WHO COMMITS A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT
27	VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION WITHIN A SEVEN-YEAR PERIOD COMMITS
28	A MISDEMEANOR, AND THE SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION SHALL
29	RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE PRIVILEGE TO HUNT OR TAKE GAME OR
30	WILDLIFE ANYWHERE WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH FOR A PERIOD OF
