AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, further 5 providing for Career and Technical Instructional Certificate; 6 and abrogating regulations. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1204.2(b) of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to 13 read: 14 Section 1204.2. Career and Technical Instructional 15 Certificate. -- * * * 16 (b) [In addition to other requirements promulgated by the 17 State Board of Education, the State Board of Education shall require an applicant to present evidence of at least four (4) 18 19 years of wage-earning experience in the occupation to be taught in order for the Secretary of Education to grant the applicant a 20

- 3 any requirement promulgated by the State Board of Education, the
- 4 Department of Education shall issue a Career and Technical
- 5 <u>Instructional I Certificate to an individual seeking a position</u>
- 6 with the primary responsibility of teaching occupational skills
- 7 <u>in State-approved career and technical education programs in the</u>
- 8 <u>public schools of this Commonwealth if the individual presents</u>
- 9 any of the following:
- 10 (1) Evidence of eight thousand (8,000) hours, equivalent to
- 11 four (4) years full-time, within their lifetime of wage-earning
- 12 <u>experience in the occupational area to be taught and</u>
- 13 <u>satisfactory achievement on an approved occupational assessment.</u>
- 14 (2) Evidence of eight thousand (8,000) hours, equivalent to
- 15 four (4) years full-time, within their lifetime of experience as
- 16 a volunteer firefighter or emergency medical technician in the
- 17 occupational area to be taught and satisfactory achievement on
- 18 <u>an approved occupational assessment.</u>
- 19 (3) Evidence of eight thousand (8,000) hours, equivalent to
- 20 four (4) years full-time, experience within their lifetime
- 21 teaching post-secondary courses in the occupational area to be
- 22 taught and satisfactory achievement on an approved occupational
- 23 assessment.

- 25 (f) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 26 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 27 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 28 "Emergency medical technician" shall mean an individual who
- 29 is certified by the Department of Health as an emergency medical
- 30 technician.

- 1 <u>"Satisfactory achievement" shall mean an acceptable level of</u>
- 2 performance as determined by the State Board of Education on the
- 3 department-prescribed assessments required under 22 Pa. Code Ch.
- 4 49 (relating to certification of professional personnel).
- 5 <u>"Volunteer firefighter" shall mean as follows:</u>
- 6 (1) A person who is a member of:
- 7 (i) a fire company organized and existing under the laws of
- 8 <u>this Commonwealth;</u>
- 9 (ii) a fire police unit, rescue squad, ambulance corps or
- 10 other like organization affiliated with one or more fire
- 11 companies; or
- 12 (iii) a fire company or affiliated organization which
- 13 participates in the fire service but does not look to that
- 14 service as his or her primary means of livelihood.
- 15 (2) A person does not lose status as a volunteer firefighter
- 16 solely because he or she may also be a paid firefighter, so long
- 17 as the person is acting within the scope of his or her
- 18 responsibilities as a member of a volunteer fire company at the
- 19 pertinent time and not within the scope of his or her
- 20 responsibilities as a paid firefighter.
- 21 Section 2. The provisions of 22 Pa. Code §§ 49.142(a)(1) and
- 22 49.151(b) are abrogated.
- 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
