Amending Titles 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) and 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, in sentencing, further providing for sentences for 3 second and subsequent offenses; and, in Pennsylvania Board of 4 Probation and Parole, further providing for parole power. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. Section 9714(g) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 10 11 § 9714. Sentences for second and subsequent offenses. 12 * * * (a.2) Parole. -- Any person sentenced under subsection (a) 1.3 14 shall not be eliqible for parole until the person has served 70% 15 of the maximum sentence as provided under subsection (a.1). * * * 16 17 [Definition.--As used in this section, the term "crime of violence" means murder of the third degree, voluntary 18

- 27 serving a sentence imposed under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9714(a)
- (relating to sentences for second and subsequent offenses)
- 29 <u>until the inmate has served at least 70% of the maximum</u>
- 30 sentence as provided under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9714(a.1).
