## AN ACT

- Authorizing the State Treasurer to waive interest on budgetary impasse investment loans.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Budgetary
- 7 Impasse Investment Loan Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Budgetary impasse." Any of the following:
- 13 (1) The period beginning July 1, 2025, and ending on the
- 14 effective date of a General Appropriation Act for the 2025-
- 15 2026 fiscal year.
- 16 (2) The period beginning July 1, 2026, and ending on the
- 17 effective date of a General Appropriation Act for the 2026-
- 18 2027 fiscal year.

- 1 "Budgetary impasse investment loan." An investment loan
- 2 entered into or otherwise authorized by the State Treasurer,
- 3 pursuant to section 301.1 of the Fiscal Code, during a budgetary
- 4 impasse, the purpose of which is to provide short-term funding
- 5 support to a loan recipient in anticipation of the receipt of
- 6 State appropriation payments subsequent to the enactment of the
- 7 General Appropriation Act for the 2025-2026 fiscal year or the
- 8 General Appropriation Act for the 2026-2027 fiscal year.
- 9 "Fiscal Code." The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176),
- 10 known as The Fiscal Code.
- 11 "Head Start." A program funded under the Federal Head Start
- 12 Act established by the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981
- 13 (Public Law 97-35, 95 Stat. 357) and carried out by a Head Start
- 14 agency or delegate agency that provides ongoing comprehensive
- 15 child development services.
- 16 "Loan recipient." Any of the following:
- 17 (1) The governing body of a county government.
- 18 (2) A domestic violence entity which receives a direct
- 19 grant from the Department of Human Services from the
- appropriation for domestic violence programs.
- 21 (3) A Head Start agency.
- 22 (4) A rape crisis entity which receives a direct grant
- from the Department of Human Services from the appropriation
- for rape crisis programs.
- 25 (5) An approved provider under the Pennsylvania Pre-K
- 26 Counts Program that receives a direct grant from the
- 27 Department of Education from the appropriation for the Pre-K
- 28 Counts Program.
- 29 Section 3. Waiver of interest.
- 30 The State Treasurer may waive or otherwise forgo, in the

- 1 State Treasurer's sole discretion, the imposition, demand and
- 2 collection of any interest, costs or fees associated with a
- 3 budgetary impasse investment loan issued pursuant to section
- 4 301.1 of the Fiscal Code, the exercise of which shall not be
- 5 deemed a violation of or otherwise inconsistent with the State
- 6 Treasurer's fiduciary investment standard under section 301.1(h)
- 7 and (i) of the Fiscal Code.
- 8 Section 4. Application.
- 9 This act shall apply retroactively to July 1, 2025.
- 10 Section 5. Effective date.
- 11 This act shall take effect immediately.
