## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further
- providing for persons required to report suspected child
- 4 abuse.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6311 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 6311. Persons required to report suspected child abuse.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (e) Additional reporting. -- A mandated reporter enumerated in
- 12 subsection (a) shall make a report of suspected child abuse in
- 13 <u>accordance with section 6313 via the Statewide toll-free</u>
- 14 telephone number under section 6332 (relating to establishment
- 15 <u>of Statewide toll-free telephone number) or by electronic</u>
- 16 submission under section 6305 (relating to electronic reporting)
- 17 <u>if the mandated reporter comes into contact with or has</u>
- 18 reasonable cause to suspect the existence of child sexual abuse

- 1 <u>material or artificially generated child sexual abuse material</u>
- 2 <u>as those terms are defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6312(g) (relating to</u>
- 3 sexual abuse of children). This subsection shall apply whether
- 4 or not the material was created, displayed or exhibited to
- 5 others by a minor. Upon receipt of a report under this
- 6 <u>subsection</u>, the department shall transmit a copy of the report
- 7 to the appropriate law enforcement agency and may transmit a
- 8 copy of the report to the appropriate county agency.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
