3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “AR–15 National Gun
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DECLARATION.**

2 An AR–15 style rifle chambered in a .223 Remington
3 round or a 5.56x45mm NATO round is hereby declared
4 to be the National Gun of the United States.
