3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pro bono Work to Em-
5 power and Represent Act of 2021” or the “POWER 2.0
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF SUNSET.**

2 Section 3(a) of the Pro bono Work to Empower and
3 Represent Act of 2018 (Public Law 115–237; 132 Stat.
4 2448) is amended by striking “for a period of 4 years”.

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
