Abridging the rights of citizens **should NOT even be considered** unless **ALL** alternatives have been exhausted.

FOAC History

We are an all-volunteer registered Political Action Committee dedicated to the preservation of Civil Rights.

The FOAC PAC was formed in 1993 and presently, we have members from all walks of life, many of whom are activists within their community, gun club and other organizations such as County Sportsmen's Leagues, the PA Gun Owners Association, the PA Sportsmen's Association, the PA Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs, the Eastern Firearms Coalition,.

We prepare and distribute questionnaires to candidates and incumbents to discern their position on and knowledge of pertinent issues. We aggressively oppose legislators who seek to supplant Freedom by restricting the legitimate, constitutional use of firearms, including personal and property protection as guaranteed by the Constitutions of the United States and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
